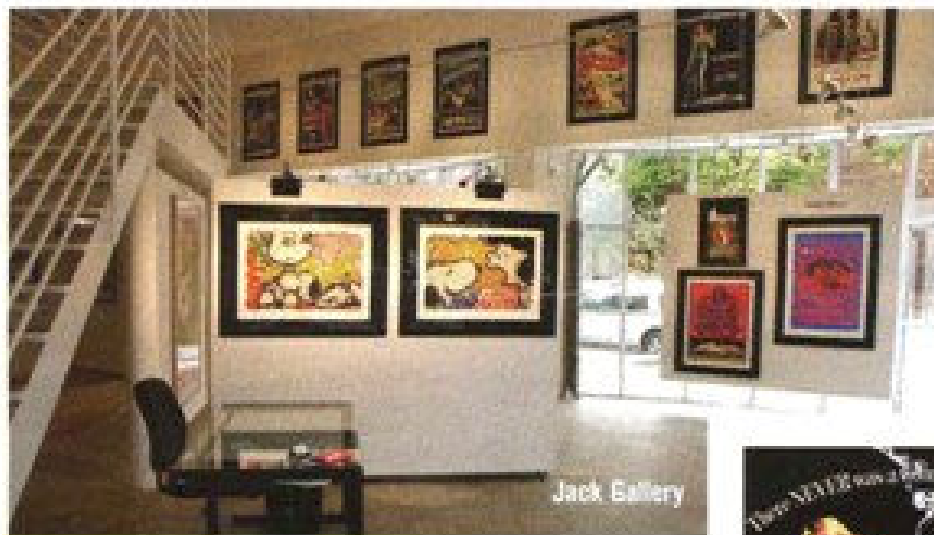

Those with fond memories of the blockbuster Toulouse-Lautrec exhibit at the Art Institute back in 2005 should pencil in some time for the new Jack Gallery on Wells and Huron. Using identical, if not the very same, presses as Lautrec himself—the gallery's parent company, S2 Art Group, claims to be in possession of five of seven surviving Parisian presses from that era—

Jack Gallery works with some of today's top pop artists to offer painstakingly fabricated, beautifully colored, limited edition lithographs. Artists represented include Tom Everhart—the only artist with a license to use the *Peanuts* comic characters in his work—Todd Goldman, of "Boys are stupid, throw rocks at them!" fame and San Francisco's Stanley Mouse, best known for his psychedelic '60s and '70s concert posters. For those whose hearts are in pop culture instead of pop art, Jack Gallery also features some to-die-for recreations of vintage classic movie posters, including iconic *King Kong* and *Gilda* prints. 678 N.
