Jack Gallery is pleased to announce the exhibition *The Art That Rocked A Decade; The Decade That Defined A Generation*

NEW ORLEANS (May 1, 2008)—Fine art paintings and lithographs by Stanley Mouse, whose psychedelic graphic style defined the art surrounding American rock music in the 1960s and 1970s, will be featured at the Jack Gallery in New Orleans in conjunction Jazz Fest on May 1 and 2. **Mouse himself will be in attendance and will be available for interviews during the exhibition.** In addition, his paintings of the new inductees to the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame will be exhibited, which consist of Leonard Cohen, The Dave Clark Five, Gamble & Huff, Little Walter, Madonna, John Mellencamp, and The Ventures. The exhibition will also feature the fine art lithographs by fellow Family Dog artists Alton Kelley, Wes Wilson and Rick Griffin.

A seminal member of the counterculture that blossomed in the Haight-Ashbury district of San Francisco in the late 60s, Mouse, along with his art partner Alton Kelley, created classic posters for concerts at the legendary Avalon Ballroom and Bill Graham's Fillmore Auditorium. His rock art pioneered the integration of fantastic, freewheeling text into American graphic design. Mouse's art has been exhibited at venues as diverse as the Smithsonian Institution, the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and the Hermitage in St. Petersburg, Russia. His work was also recently featured in the San Diego Museum of Art's "High Societies" exhibit along with the works of Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec.

The Atelier of S² Art Group has produced hand-signed and numbered lithograph recreations pulled from plates hand-drawn by Stanley Mouse in conjunction with Rhino Entertainment for Jack Gallery. Each was pulled by hand on extremely rare, antique lithography presses utilizing "low-tech" direct traditional lithography methods.
